1:15 - 1:45 Title: Tri-State Geocaching; Virginia, Tennessee, and Kentucky

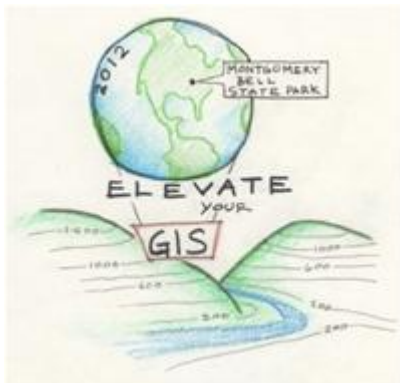
